Summer Reading Tips & Expectations

- You will need your book in your classes - both English and Social Studies - for discussions once the school year begins.
- Assessments, such as writing assignments and tests, will be assigned in your English and Social Studies class at the beginning of the school year.
- Read in a timely manner and take notes which will refresh your memory before the start of school in September. If you finish your reading early in the summer, reviewing the text before the beginning of school is strongly advised.
- What was the author's purpose in writing the book? (Make sure to read "A Note from Mona Golabek" to help answer this question.)
- What types of sources were used to write the book? (Look at the Resources section at the end of the book.)
- What are the main points the author makes in the book? (Consider the organization of the book and be sure to read the Epilogue.)
