



## 2019–2020 Book Process

*Here you will find step by step instructions for purchasing books and other materials for the 2019–2020 school year.*

### Overview

#### 1. Course List

The first thing you will want to do is consult your **Course List**. This list tells you what courses you will be taking during the 2019–2020 school year. Your **Course List** will be mailed to you **July 1, 2019**.

#### 2. Book List

Once you know what courses you are taking, you will want to consult the **Book List**. The **Book List** is organized by subject area and by course. It will tell you exactly what books and materials you need and where to find them. This year's **Book List** will be finalized and published on the **New Student Information**<sup>1</sup> on our website for new students, and on **PlusPortals**<sup>2</sup> for returning students by **July 9, 2019**.

#### 3. Purchase Materials

Now that you know what books and materials you need, you can begin purchasing. There are two main sources\* that you will use to procure your materials. Links will be available on the **New Student Information** page for new students and on **PlusPortals** for returning students:

- **NHS Online Used Book Sale** – The National Honor Society will run an online used book sale for all mathematics hardcover, physical science, Conceptual Physics, English 1 (hardcover text), Latin hardcover (Jenney), Tejidos, and Le Petit Prince. The Google Form will be available on **July 9, 2019** on the **New Student Information** page and **PlusPortals**. Parents will receive a confirmation email from a member of NHS and will be able to pay by check and pick up their books on August 26 (Freshwomen Community Day) or September 3 and 4 (first days of school). Specific pick up times will be shared with you in your August Reminder Email and/or your Back to School Letter.
- **Follett Bookstore** – Follett Online Bookstore will open on **July 9, 2019**. This site will allow you to purchase or rent new and used textbooks for your courses.

**Purchase Your Fontbonne Planner & Chromebook Insurance** – All students are required to purchase a Fontbonne Academic Planner and Chromebook Insurance. The planner and insurance plan can be purchased using a link on the **New Student Information** page and **PlusPortals**. The link will be active on **July 9, 2019**.
