

## Health Information

All international students must have the following documentation before they can begin classes at Fontbonne Academy:

- o A complete physical examination within the last 12 months (see form)
- o Immunization record of required vaccines
  - o DPT (Diphtheria/Pertussis/Tetanus): at least 3 doses, with last dose after age 4
  - o DT (Diphtheria/Tetanus): booster required every 10 years
  - o Polio: at least 3 doses, with last dose after age 4
  - o Measles: at least 2 doses after age 1
  - o Mumps: one dose either on or after age 1
  - o Rubella: one dose either on or after age 1
  - o Chicken Pox: If student has never had chicken pox, one dose required.
  - o Hepatitis A & B: at least 2 dose of Hepatitis A and 3 doses of Hepatitis B
  - o Also suggested: Meningococcal, HPV, and influenza vaccines
- o Before entering the school the student must have the following:
  - o Proof of a negative ppd or negative chest xray two weeks before entering the United States.
  - o Proof of a negative second ppd planted after 8 weeks of being here at Fontbonne Academy (long incubation period of TB).
  - o When students return from summer break, the **same thing will be required each** and every year.
  - o After vacations, breaks or brief trips home the student will be seen by the nurse, assessed and given an appointment for another assessment 8 weeks later.
- o Proof of valid health insurance
- o Health emergency form (completed in U.S.)

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
