

2020-2021 Book Process

Here you will find step by step instructions for purchasing books and other materials for the 2020-2021 school year.

Overview

1. Course List

The first thing you will want to do is consult your **Course List**. This list tells you what courses you will be taking during the 2020–2021 school year. Your **Course List** will be mailed to you **July 1, 2020**.

2. Book List

Once you know what courses you are taking, you will want to consult the **Book List**. The **Book List** is organized by subject area and by course. It will tell you exactly what books and materials you need and where to find them. This year's **Book List** will be finalized and published on the **New Student Information**¹ on our website for new students, and on **PlusPortals**² for returning students by **July 9, 2020**.

3. Purchase Materials

Now that you know what books and materials you need, you can begin purchasing. For some materials, a direct link to purchase can be found on the Book List. Unless otherwise noted, families are encouraged to purchase required books and materials through Amazon or Barnes and Nobles. Families can purchase through other vendors as well. When purchasing, please make sure to select the correct edition.

Purchase Your Fontbonne Planner – All students are required to purchase a Fontbonne Academic Planner. This item can be purchased using a link on the **New Student Information** page and **PlusPortals**. The link will be active on **July 9, 2020**.

Chromebook Insurance - Any student that is using a school-issued Chromebook is required to purchase Chromebook Insurance. This is required for all students in grades 9 - 11. Grade 12 students continuing the Chromebook program must also purchase Chromebook Insurance. Students can purchase this using a link on the **New Student Information** page and **PlusPortals.** The link will be active on **July 9, 2020**.

Additional Supplies - We do not offer a full list of supplies for students as each course requires different materials. Students will receive a list of required supplies for each of their classes on the first day of school. We recommend students bring a notebook and writing materials to the first day of classes.
